1. Pledge of Allegiance

2. Roll Call

3. Public Portion

Chris Kopjanski, a Derby resident, forwarded the commissioners a written complaint regarding the pistol permit process. Commissioner Estwan informed Mr. Kopjanski that they would research the allegations made in the letter and someone would get back to him to discuss it further.

4. Deletion, correction, adoption of agenda

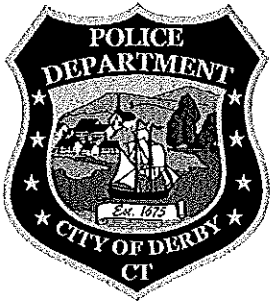
Commissioner DiSorbo motioned to accept the agenda as is and Commissioner Pollastro seconded. The motion carried without further discussion.

7. New Business

Chief Narowski briefed the commissioners on the school security forum that was held at the high school on 04 APR 13. A copy of the presentation was provided for review.

The commissioners were also informed of an ongoing issue with the Chairman of the Tax Board regarding the authorization to hire three replacement officers to cover three officers that are planning to retire and the hiring of two additional officers thereby raising the department's staffing level from 31 to 33 full time sworn personnel. Chief Narowski forwarded the commissioners a partial copy of last year's budget presentation (attached) stating the new hire request and advised them of a press article that was written the day after last year's presentation which also stated that the chief requests. The tax board had approved that budget request, including hiring the three replacement officers and two additional officers, last year.

8. Department Reports

Chief Narowski updated the commissioners on the department's patrol activity. He also reviewed the status of the police department's budget.

9. Communications

There were no communications.

10. Traffic Authority Business

The commissioners discussed the request from Paugasset Hook and Ladder to conduct a boot drive fundraising event on Saturday, May 25 from 9:00 am – 3:00 pm. The requested locations of the boot drive are as follows:

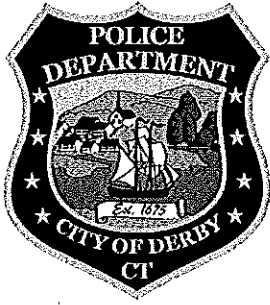
- a. Intersection of Sodom Lane and Marshall Lane
