There was no old business to discuss.

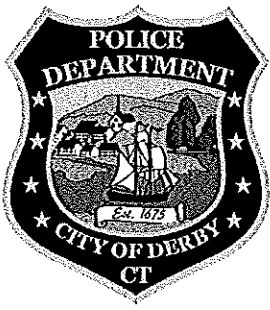
7. New Business
