7. New Business

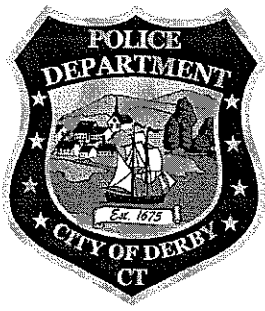
There was no new business discussed.
