6. Old Business

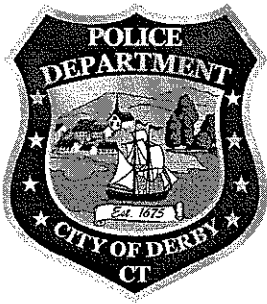
There was no old business discussed.
