Commissioner Pollastro motioned to accept the 08 APR 13 minutes and Commissioner DiSorbo seconded. The motion carried without further discussion.

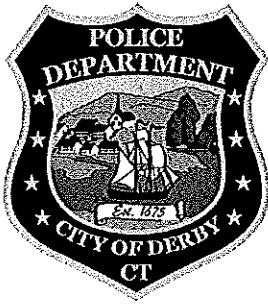
6. Old Business
