6. Department Reports

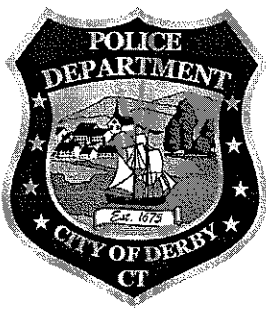
The department reports were not reviewed due to the absence of Chief Mascolo.
