The meeting was called to order at 5:30 P.M. by Chairman Estwan.

1. Pledge of Allegiance

2. Roll Call

Present were Commissioners Estwan and DiSorbo. Also present was Chief Narowski and Deputy Chief Todd.

3. Public Portion

No one from the public wished to comment.

4. Deletion, correction, adoption of agenda

Since this was a special meeting, no alterations could be made. Commissioner DiSorbo motioned to accept the agenda as is and Commissioner Estwan seconded.

5. Acceptance of Previous Meeting's Minutes

Commissioner DiSorbo motioned to accept the 15 FEB 11 minutes, Commissioner Estwan seconded, and the motion carried.

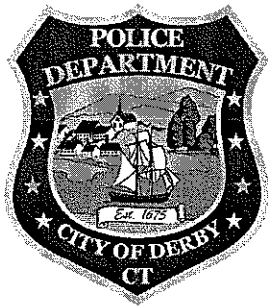
6. Old Business

There was no old business discussed.

7. New Business

The commissioners were given a presentation on the reorganization of the department by Chief Narowski. Effective 28 FEB 11, two new sections were created. LT Stanko is now the Operations Commander and LT Frosceno is the Administrative Commander. One Lieutenant's position has been eliminated. The department has also added two sergeants' positions, bringing the total number of sergeants from three to five. One sergeant will be managing the detective bureau and the other will be a swing shift patrol sergeant.

Commissioner DiSorbo motioned to accept the elimination of one Lieutenant position, Commissioner Estwan seconded and the motion carried.

## **8. Department Reports**

Chief Narowski updated the commissioners on the department's patrol activity. He also reviewed the status of the police department's budget and briefed the commissioners on this past month's department endeavors.

## **9. Communications**

The commissioners were forwarded a memo stating that Patrolman Dupke was appointed to the temporary position of acting sergeant.

## **10. Traffic Authority Business**

The Board reviewed the LTA report.

Upon recommendation from SGT Boulton, Commissioner Estwan motioned to post a limited time parking sign for one parking place in front of Milady's Salon located at 211 Elizabeth Street. Commissioner DiSorbo seconded the motion and the motion carried.

The commissioners were forwarded a copy of a Traffic Control Signal Application from the Valley Council of Governments for the Clifton Avenue /Atwater Avenue at Division Street intersection. The proposed revision is to add "No Turn on Red" signage at all four approaches.

## **11. Executive Session**

A motion to go into executive session at 6:00 pm and have Chief Narowski and Deputy Chief Todd present was made by Commissioner DiSorbo, seconded by Commissioner Estwan, and carried unanimously. The purpose of the executive session was to discuss the following items:
